Online safety tip of the week

Information from National Online Safety regarding the game Grand Theft Auto;

GTA includes content that is inappropriate for anyone under the age of 18, including sex, nudity, violence, profane language and substance abuse. These are the main components that make up the game – you have to do certain things and witness certain things in order to move on in the game. Exposing your child to this kind of content could affect their morals and understanding of right and wrong. Additionally, your child could become desensitised to similar situations, reinforcing the fact that they would find it hard to differentiate between right/wrong and good/bad.
